The Program

Learning that strengthens leadership, communication, and heart-centered care

Through ground-based equine-assisted learning, participants are invited to slow down, engage in inward reflection, and develop self-awareness, coherence, and presence. Participants work alongside the horses as collaborative partners, receiving immediate, non-judgmental feedback that supports the development of intuition, reflective practice, and embodied awareness.



Program details

- Format: 12 hours over 2 days
 - Day 1: 2 hr interactive virtual session where concepts and techniques are introduced
 - Day 2: In-person hands on facilitated equine interactions at the ranch in Nicasio, CA
- Group Size: 8 - 12 participants
- Cost: \$950 (Includes all materials, drinks, snacks, and lunch)
- No horse experience required!
 - All equine work is done on the ground. There will be no riding of horses.
